By entering the Summer Superdraw 2019 you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions ("The Rules"). The current rules will be posted on the Website. A paper copy may be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to The Hospice Lottery Partnership (HLP) offices at the above address.

HLP reserves the right to add/decrease the number of beneficiary Hospice Partners within The Hospice Lottery Partnership at any time. HLP reserves the right to amend or modify these Terms and Conditions without notice.

HLP is the Promoter of this Prize Draw which is a 'Society Lottery' within the meaning of the Gambling Act 2005. The responsible person is David Griffiths. All profits from HLP Summer Superdraw 2019 go directly towards funding the hospice services of Florence Nightingale Hospice Charity, Michael Sobell Hospice Charity, Rennie Grove Hospice Care, South Bucks Hospice and The Hospice of St Francis ("The Hospice Partners") which all support patients with life-limiting or terminal illnesses, and their families and carers at no cost.

1. To enter the Summer Superdraw 2019 you must be a UK resident aged 16 (sixteen) years or over.
2. Employees and Board Directors of The Hospice Lottery Partnership and some of their close family members may not participate in the Superdraws.
3. There will be 6 (six) guaranteed prizes in the main draw which will be issued in the form of cheques. First prize £2,000; second prize £250; third prize £100; fourth prize will be 3 (three) prizes of £50.
4. There will be 10 (ten) guaranteed £10 Marks and Spencer gift cards in the Fast Reply Draw.
5. All tickets shall be priced at £1. Entry into the Fast Reply Draw will be free to all those who enter the Summer Superdraw 2019 and correct monies have been paid. There is a limit of 50 Summer Superdraw 2019 tickets that may be purchased. The minimum purchase amount is 1 ticket (=£1) for entry into the Summer Superdraw and the Fast Reply Draw.
6. The draw for the Fast Reply Draw will be made on 29 May 2019. To be eligible to be entered into this draw, HLP must receive your correctly completed Summer Superdraw 2019 tickets along with payment by 10am on the morning of 20 May 2019. 10 (ten) winning tickets will be drawn to receive a £10 (ten pounds) Marks and Spencer gift card. No cash alternatives will be offered. Fast Reply entrants received after this date will be entered into the Summer Superdraw 2019 only.
7. All lottery entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1 per ticket to enter the Summer Superdraw 2019 or Fast Reply Draw does not guarantee that they will win any prize.
8. The Summer Superdraw 2019 will be drawn on 17 July 2019. Closing date for mailed entries into the draw will be 12 July 2019, though ticket sales may continue throughout venues and by telephone or through the website at hospicelottery.org.uk. Entries received after the draw date will be treated as a donation.
9. Full payment for each ticket must be received either in the form of cash or cleared funds before the ticket(s) can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received either in the form of cash or cleared funds are eligible to win a prize.
10. If a cash prize is awarded, this will be made by cheque in the name of the entrant only.
11. Winners will be notified by letter or telephone.
12. All entrants are solely responsible for providing HLP with their accurate and up-to-date contact details and HLP will in no way be liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to any errors, omission or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising HLP of the change. In the event of winning cheques remaining un-cashed due to changes not being notified to the lottery office, the promoter reserves the right to return unclaimed prizes to the HLP funds after a period of six months.
13. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in promotional activity and HLP reserves the right to use the name and town of the winner, their photograph and any audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity unless prior notification has been received.
14. Each Summer Superdraw 2019 ticket number is unique.
15. HLP shall not be liable to the entrant for any loss or damage suffered or arising from: Any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery methods used by HLP or the entrant; Any delays or failures in the Banking system used by HLP or the entrant; Any event beyond the reasonable control of HLP.
16. Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and HLP.
17. HLP operate a complaints policy, details of which are available by writing to HLP. Any complaints relating to the Summer Superdraw 2019 should be addressed to the Chief Executive either by telephone or in writing. In the event of a complaint or dispute not being resolved, it will be referred to the Chairperson and then to arbitration. As a member of the Hospice Lotteries Association, this will be referred to The Independent Betting Adjudication Services Limited (IBAS).
18. HLP is committed to protecting member's privacy. We promise to comply with all data protection requirements and protect your personal data. An 'opt out' of receiving further tickets from HLP is available on the reply slip in the pack.
19. HLP reserves the right to disqualify or refuse any application for tickets if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.
20. A member of the Hospice Lotteries Association and The Lotteries Council, HLP promotes responsible gambling and offers individuals access to support from BeGambleAware (begambleaware.org). An instruction to be self excluded, as defined in the Gambling Act 2005, from HLP lotteries and Superdraws may be submitted in writing, emailed or telephoned to the HLP office.
21. In the event that any provision of these Terms is held to be illegal, invalid, void or unenforceable, it shall be severed from the remaining provisions which shall continue in full force and effect.
22. These rules shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of England and Wales.
